The One Minute Film Program is an outreach initiative of AFLOOP, the Atlantic Filmmakers Cooperative. The One Minute Film Program provides people who have little or no filmmaking experience with the opportunity to create their first one-minute film.

Through the program recipients participate in a series of workshops and are provided with all the equipment and supplies necessary to make a film. Each participant will also have an experienced filmmaker as his/her mentor to offer help throughout the process.

Anyone interested in applying to the One Minute Film Program is welcome to attend one of our information sessions. This is a great chance to learn more about the program, view examples of films made through the program, and get application tips.

<p>PROPOSED TITLE OF YOUR ONE MINUTE FILM A carefully chosen title can be a great short cut to setting the tone for your film</p>	
<p>IN ONE SENTENCE, TELL US ABOUT YOUR IDEA FOR YOUR ONE MINUTE FILM Like the title, choose your words carefully! This sentence should be to the point, attention grabbing and clear!</p>	
<p>TELL US ABOUT YOURSELF Attach a SHORT bio explaining what skills and interests you'll bring to the One Minute Film Program – include any previous film, video or other arts and community related activities you have participated in.</p>	
<p>DESCRIBE YOUR IDEA IN MORE DETAIL Include anything that will help the jury better understand the film you have in mind – basic story, characters, genre etc. You can attach an additional sheet if more room is needed. The total length should be no longer than 1/2 of an 8 1/2 x 11 letter sized sheet of paper.</p>	

You may include storyboards, pictures or any other visual materials that will help explain your idea. However, you are NOT required to do so.
