Additional Support Material May Include (optional but may strengthen your application):

2. Script (Max 5 pages)
 - Scripts should be suitable in length for a five minute short and should not propose special effects or technical requirements beyond what is generally available.
3. Story Boards and/or Shot List
4. Filmography and Resume
 - For any films listed include your role, the length, format, and any awards or screenings.
5. Vimeo link to Support Film or Video
 - One Vimeo link to a film or video work you created.

Applications will be reviewed with the following scoring system:

- Artistic potential of your idea - does the idea inspire, excite audiences? (1–10 points)
- Applicant suitability - how will you benefit from this experience? (1–5 points)
- Feasibility - is the proposed idea feasible? (1–5 points)

Eligibility:

To be eligible to apply to this initiative, applicants must be 18 years or older, and indicate a connection to one of the following five languages being celebrated by the Languages of Nova Scotia Initiative: A' Ghàidhlig / Gaelic, Farsi / Persian, Français / French, Maritime Sign Language / American Sign Language, L'nui'simk / Mi'kmaq.
